The National Association for School Psychologists's PREPaRE curriculum provides relevant school personnel with comprehensive training on how to establish and serve on school safety and crisis response teams. The workshops integrate the roles of existing school staff and community providers related to five crisis preparedness mission areas (prevention, protection, mitigation, response, and recovery) and ground them in ongoing school safety efforts.

PREPaRE's model emphasizes the following hierarchal and sequential set of activities:

- P- Prevent and prepare for psychological trauma
- R- Reaffirm physical health and perceptions of security and safety
- E- Evaluate psychological trauma risk
- P- Provide interventions

- R- Respond to psychological needs
- E- Examine the effectiveness of crisis prevention and intervention
